One of the more common uses for drama in a ministry setting is to act out a Bible story for an audience. But there is more than one way to tell the same story! In this workshop, we will play with well-known Bible stories and various techniques for putting them on stage, including modernizing the plot and telling the story through monologues. There will be a showcase at the end of the day, allowing families to see what the students have done.

Ever wonder how sound happens in a show? How can it sound so seamless? Where do you get the sounds, or can you make them yourself? We will explore how sound happens, where to find

sounds, what makes sounds appropriate for drama, comedy, musicals, etc., what music can you use legally, and more. You will walk away with a complete soundtrack for a show (each person in the class will have a different show).

**Note:** Each participant must bring recyclable materials such as newspaper, shopping bags, trash bags, duct tape, fabric, trim, etc. We will have some items available at CSDC but not enough to supply every group with all their materials

Using found items, such as thrift store clothing, newspaper, duct tape, etc., the groups will make a costume appropriate to the era or the play. Creations will be unveiled during the free fashion show for family and friends.

#### **AUDITION**

**Date:** June 14, 7-9 p.m.

Grades: 6th-12th

**Cost: Audition is free**

**Registration Deadline: June 13**

Once you're registered for the audition, you will be sent an audition form. Fill it out and send it back.

The audition will consist of cold readings - students will read the scripts provided during the audition.

Students will need to be present the entire audition.

All students who audition will be cast.

After students are notified about casting results, students may register for the camp.

**Optional:** Prepare a one minute monologue and bring headshot/resume

### **CAMP**

**Camp Dates: July 5-July 16, Monday through Friday**

**Rehearsal times: 9 a.m.-9 p.m. Students will only need to attend during their rehearsal(s).**

Each play will have a 3 hour block of rehearsal time daily for the first week and for Monday through Wednesday of the second week.

Everyone will attend on Thursday, July 15, from 9 a.m.-5 p.m., for Tech and Dress rehearsals.

Friday, July 16, all students will be called from 1-4:30 p.m. for the final dress rehearsal.

Four short plays will be prepared for two performances. This camp is designed for students who love theatre! It's a rigorous, exciting program, dedicated to actor training, theatre fun, and the World Premiere productions of our new plays. Besides being a great opportunity to learn about theatre and the fun process that goes along with producing shows, this camp provides a supportive environment where everyone is encouraged to grow and to develop new friendships. The camp will be filled with learning and rehearsing, culminating in two performances at the end of the two weeks.

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### **Not Your Ordinary Face Theatrical Makeup Camp**

**Dates: July 19-24, 9:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.**

Grades: 6th to Adult

Teacher: Marla Ripps

**Cost:** \$200

**Supply Fee:** \$75 - all supplies are included

**Non-Refundable deposit:** \$75

**Registration deadline:** July 12

Minimum number of students: 4

Maximum number of students: 10

Stage makeup is not the same as makeup for film, and it varies depending on whether you are in an intimate setting or on a big stage. We will explore, discuss, dissect, and apply each of the styles listed below during this camp. Students will be divided into teams of 2. Morning will be discussion, lecture, designing, and in the case of the airbrush techniques, training. Afternoon will be spent applying makeup on each other.

Bring a lunch. Refrigerator and microwave are available.

Makeup styles covered:

- Basic Stage makeup: Contouring, highlighting, eyes (mascara, eyeliner, eyeshadow)
- Old age
- Wounds, Bruising, etc. If time allows
- Fantasy/Animal
- Airbrush techniques
- Small Prosthetics - incorporating them into your makeup design

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### **Stage Combat: Back to the Basics**

Whether you have experience in stage combat or not, this camp will go over the basics of falling, pushing, slapping, and punching, while keeping everyone involved safe. Use these moves as you go forward on your theatre journey. The last day of camp will be a scene presentation to show off your new skills.
